### CONNECTING GCs WITH SIMILAR SIZED LEGAL TEAM

GCN is once again organising six sessions will be held of one and a half hour: three on Wednesday 27 May and three on Thursday 4 June at Hofstede De Nieuwe Ham, a centrally located farmhouse with ample parking on the outskirts of Utrecht.

The in-depth exchange during the Peergroups works as follows:

- All participants share the key challenges they are currently facing.
- Based on these, we offer each other advice, perspectives and practical examples.
- Participants indicate the topics in which they have above-average experience, and on which others may approach them for knowledge, tips or sparring.
- These points will be noted by GCN and shared afterward with your group participants only, enabling you to follow up with one another if desired.

In short: a compact, practical session that is directly relevant and useful.
